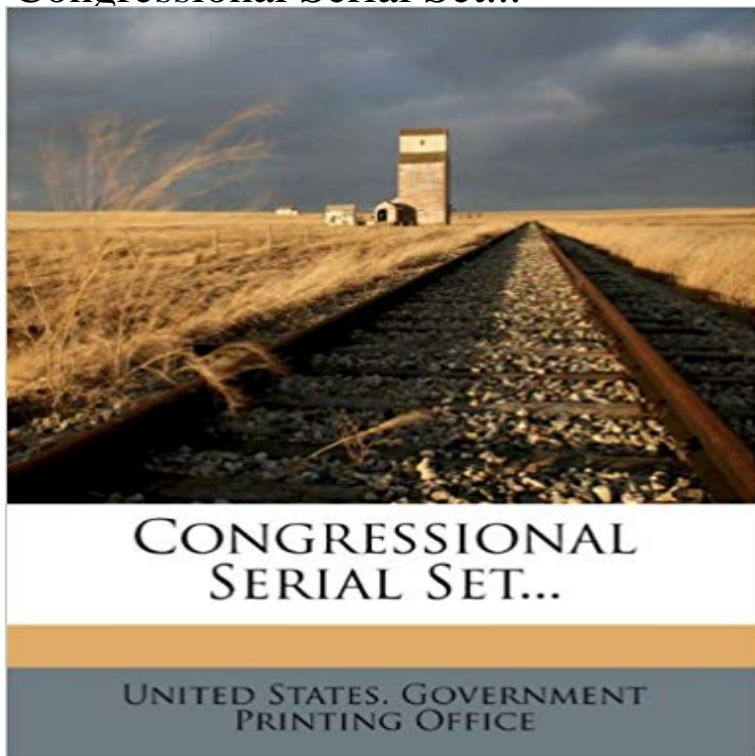


## Congressional Serial Set...
