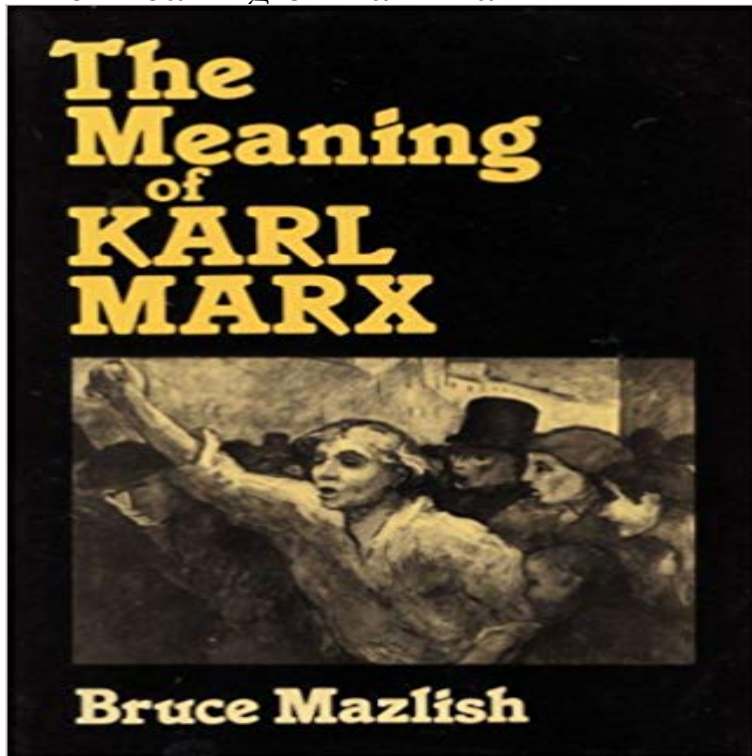


The Meaning of Karl Marx
