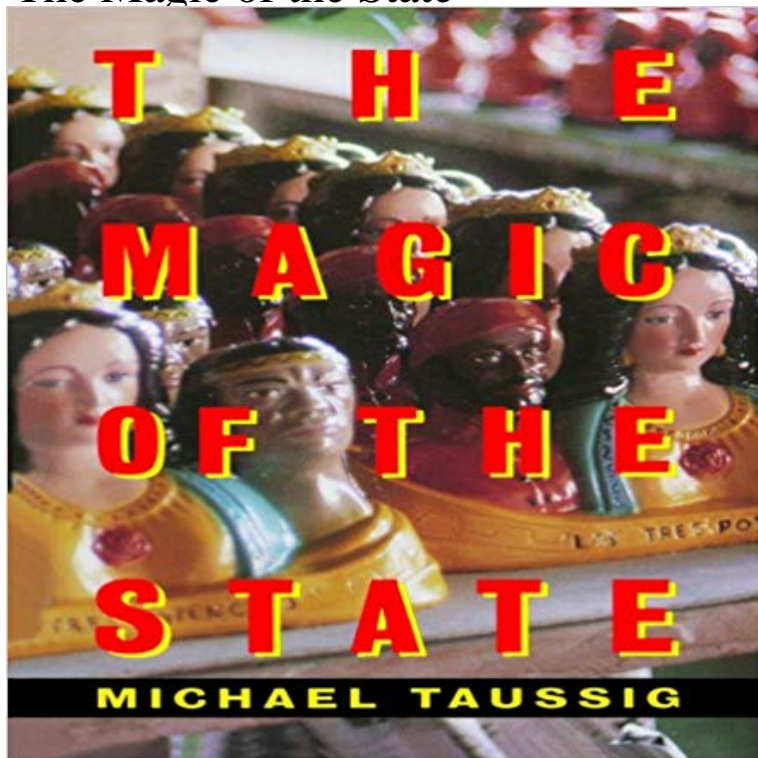


## The Magic of the State
