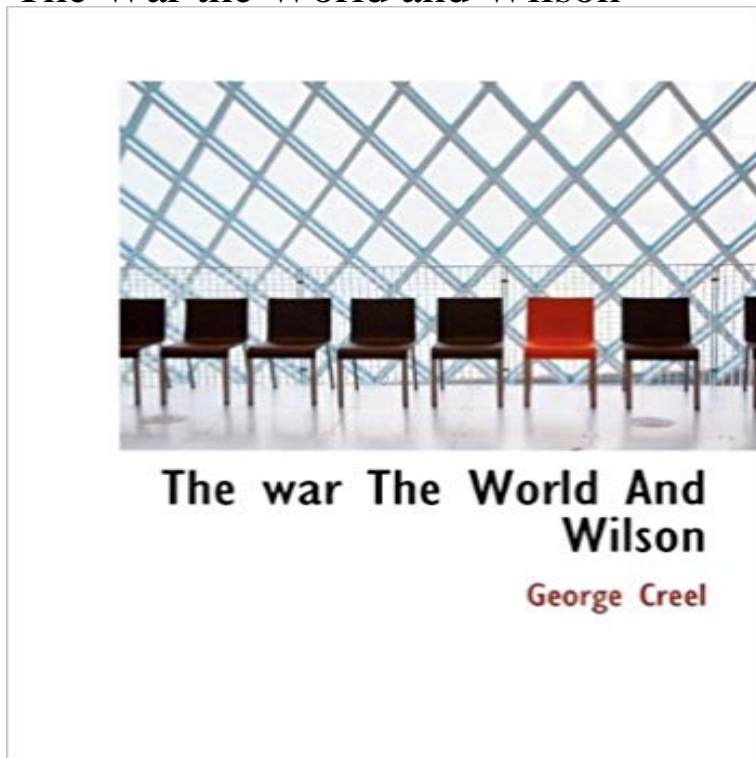


The War the World and Wilson
